- 2) INVOCATION, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE Jalifi gave the invocation
- Discuss and take possible action on FY2022 Audit as presented by KML Certified Public Accountants.
- Mayor/council/committee/department head/organization reports Police Chief Moncier- gave the monthly PD activity report; Robert King – gave the EMS monthly activity report; Justin Mills – Thanks to PD for supporting the Fire Department; Michelle Booth – Successful Food and Arts Festival raised \$4100, split between VFD and PD;

**Dortha Pekar** – May 6 need a variance for Canons on May 6; **Toni Capretta** - Bluewater Highway work; flashing red lights on the stop signs.

Oscar Jalifi – Road repair in Surfside Shores; Stahlman Park parking spot block.

**Bob Petty** – asked for an update on the negotiations with the SPOT project people.

Gregg Bisso – Freeport waterline update; CDBG MIT we submitted an application for drainage project city wide and streets repaving. We have had 2 of 4 lke appeals returned with positive results. Gerber is working on a meeting with SPOT management.
