- Discuss and take possible action to adopt the 2018 version of the International Residential Code and the 2018 version of the International Building Code. Hart/Bisso
- 7) Discuss and take possible action on proposal from Kimley-Horn regarding the AirVac sewer system.

8) Discuss and take possible action to extend the Declaration of Disaster that was declared by Mayor Bisso due to Hurricane Nicholas.
