#### **COUNCIL MEETING:**

## 1) CALL TO ORDER, QUORUM IN ATTENDANCE

Mayor Bisso called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and recognized a quorum of Council members were present. Jennie Green-Prats was absent, Gerber was not in attendance at this time. Gerber arrived at 7:05 p.m.

- 2) INVOCATION, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE Jalifi gave the invocation.
- 3) Mayor/council/committee/department head/organization reports
  Police Chief Moncier- gave the monthly PD activity report;
  Robert King gave the EMS monthly activity report;
  Sean Robertson Kudos to the city leadership and city department heads;
  Zach Parsch Recognized Erick Ingram thanks for all you do;
  Gregg Bisso We fielded questions from the GLO regarding the groin project; still waiting on the sewer grant from the HGAC/GLO, we have been preparing for emergency management and the budget workshops.

  Erick Ingram gave monthly activity report.
- 4) Business of visitors not on the agenda. Coral Court and Gulfway residents reported that they have really smelly water.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA:**

- Motion was made by Jalifi to approve the consent agenda. Motion was seconded by Parsch and passed unanimously.
- 6) Discuss and make recommendations to add or change ordinance to provide more opportunities for business development within city limits and beach to increase general fund revenue and build/appoint an Economic Development Committee.

Motion was made by Parsch to create an Economic Development Committee. Motion was seconded by Robertson and passed 4 for, 1 against (Gerber).

7) Discuss and take possible action to adopt Ordinance 2023-05-16A 2018 IBC to address commercial development of property.

Motion was made by Robertson to approve Ordinance 2021-05-16A adopting the 2018 IBC. Motion was seconded by Gerber and passed 4 for, 1 against (Gerber).

8) Discuss and take action to create a workshop to discuss plans for city buildings such as City Hall, Stahlman Park and barn storage for heavy equipment.

Jalifi asked to plan a workshop for these issues to avoid filling a regular meeting agenda.

9) Discuss and take action regarding the leasing or purchasing of heavy equipment by the city.

Robertson summarized his detailed research and recommended the purchase of a mini excavator and gave some suggestions for leasing such as length of term for lease, etc., and Parsch recommended corrosion protection on all equipment.

10) Discuss and take action to limit agenda item submissions to 3 items per alderman per month.

#### **ORDINANCE 2023.08.08A**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE II, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF SURFSIDE BEACH, TEXAS; AMENDING AGENDA PREPARATION ORDINANCES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Village of Surfside Beach, Texas, has determined that adoption of this Ordinance is necessary to the health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of said City and the members of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Ordinance was adopted at a meeting which was open to the public and preceded by proper notice, as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Local Government Code (the Open Meetings Act).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF SURFSIDE BEACH, TEXAS:

FIRST, the findings and recitations set out in the Preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and they are hereby adopted by the City Council and made part hereof for all purposes.

**SECOND**, That Chapter 2, Article 2, Section 2-92 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Surfside Beach, Texas, is amended as follows:

## Sec. 2-92. – Agenda.

(b) Preparation. The agenda for all regular meetings shall be prepared by the secretary under the direction of the mayor or the mayor pro tem. The agenda for any special or emergency meeting shall be prepared by the secretary under the direction of the person calling such meeting. The agenda for any regular meeting shall contain any item of old business tabled from a previous meeting and up to three (3) new agenda items per councilmember, which that member determines to place thereon; provided that any item of new business is given to the secretary for placement on the agenda not later than 12:00 noon on the Thursday next, preceding the regular meeting. The agenda for any emergency or any special meeting shall contain such items of old business or new business as the person calling such meeting desires to place thereon.

THIRD, This Ordinance shall be and is hereby declared to be cumulative of all other Ordinances of the Village of Surfside Beach and this Ordinance shall not operate to repeal or affect any of such other Ordinances except insofar as the provisions thereof might be inconsistent or in conflict

with the provisions of this Ordinance, in which event such conflicting provisions, if any, in such other Ordinance or Ordinances are hereby repealed.

**FOURTH**, If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase, of this Ordinances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

FIFTH, All of the regulations provided in this Ordinance are hereby declared to be governmental and for the health, safety, and welfare of the general public. Any member of the City Council or any City official or employee charged with the enforcement of this Ordinance, acting for the Village of Surfside Beach in the discharge of his/her duties, shall not thereby render himself/herself personally liable; and he/she is hereby relieved from all personal liability for any damage that might accrue to persons or property as a result of any act required or permitted in the discharge of his/her said duties.

**SIXTH**, Any violation of this Ordinance can be enjoined by a suit filed in the name of the Village of Surfside Beach in a court of competent jurisdiction, and this remedy shall be in addition to any penal provision in this Ordinance or in the Code of the Village of Surfside Beach.

#### **ORDINANCE 2023.08.08B**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 36 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF SURFSIDE BEACH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE SIGN ORDINANCE AND BRINGING THE POLITICAL SIGN SECTION INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that this Ordinance was adopted at a meeting which was open to the public and preceded by proper notice, as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Local Government Code (the Open Meetings Act).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF SURFSIDE BEACH, TEXAS:

**FIRST**, the findings and recitations set out in the Preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and they are hereby adopted by the City Council and made part hereof for all purposes.

**SECOND**, That Chapter 36-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Surfside Beach. Texas, is amended as follows:

Sec. 36-13. - Exceptions and exemptions.

(9) Political signs.

Temporary political campaign signs shall comply with the Texas Election Code.

**THIRD**, If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase, of this Ordinances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
