Public Notice to Boil Water

A water line break has caused the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to require our water system, Village of Surfside Beach, Texas PWS TX020037, to notify customers of the need to boil their water before consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, boil and cool water for drinking, cooking, and making ice before use. Bring the water to a vigorous, rolling boil, and then boil it for <u>two (2)</u> <u>minutes</u>. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When boiling water is no longer necessary, water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. We shall issue instructions to discontinue boiling in the same manner as we issued this notice.
