Building Department Monthly Council Report: October 2025

- 1. **Board of Adjustments:** Demolition of 623 Beach Front, after working with the owner they decided to take it down themselves, I have issued a demo permit and the contractor is scheduled to start tomorrow 10-15-25.
- 2. **Park Event Stage:** I was asked to complete the structure before the 25th of this month which I did accomplish, and it's now waiting for power.
- 3. **Salty Pelican:** They are currently working on their drawings for fire suppression requirements throughout the building and the designs for the elevators along with concrete parking which will continue with the reserve parking lot to the rear of the building.
- 4. The Breeze Hotel and RV Park: I've been working with the owner and contractor over the past few months to not only update the current structure but also in conjunction with the addition of a new restaurant and bar, also expanding the RV park to include the opposite side of Bluewater Hwy and include a fitness center.
- 5. **Zoning & Code:** Since my last report we have Issued 26 building permits to include 4 new homes and 2 home demolitions, 19 code enforcement violations with 11 being completed so far.

Community & Operational Updates:

- Training Conducted:
 - ➤ Monthly training consisted of Emergency vehicle driving
 - Additional monthly training included testing over the following medications that we carry and can administer on a daily basis Epinephrine (a cardiac medication and a medication for allergic reactions) and Glucagon (a medication for diabetic emergencies.
 - ➤ We now have 2 additional CPR instructors (Our EMS supervisor Ashlee Conrad and our EMS team leader Tiffany Colquitt.
 - ➤ I will be looking at sending our EMS providers back to school to advance their certification/license level. I currently have staff interested in doing this. They will need to sign a contract committing to work for Surfside Beach EMS for a minimum of 2 years if they advance to the Intermediate level or 3 years if they advance to the Paramedic level. I think this will benefit not only myself as management and not needing to constantly re-hire personnel to maintain a full roster but you as the public as you will be able to become familiar with the people that you are depending on to take care of you in a time of need

• Equipment/Vehicle Status:



- We recently took ownership of the new ambulance that was approved by council in September. We found a few items that we were not happy with; after speaking with the company, we bought it from, they are fixing all the items that we spoke about. We are hoping to have the ambulance back, decaled and in-service no later than the ends of this month. That will depend on when we can get the State here to do their final inspection.
- The old ambulance a/c unit and shoreline plugs has been repaired, once we get the new ambulance in service that unit will become a back up unit. The mayor, myself, code enforcement and public works have come up with a plan to build a small "lean to style building on the side of the current EMS bay where the old unit will be housed, I will speak with John about running the electric for the unit/Building. This will allow us to keep the unit plugged in and temperature controlled and security as well.

Public Outreach:

Everyone remember if you or your family are interested in obtaining your CPR certification, please contact me in the office and we can get a time scheduled. The class takes about 4 hours to complete; it will require some hands-on skills testing. The maximum student to instructor ratio is 6 students to 1 instructor. The cost will be \$20.00/person (card cost and administrative fee)

Staffing:

- We have ended the weekend beach patrol for the season. The season showed a great success in response times and care for beach related calls, we will be starting the planning process for next year, we will look at what worked good, what needs fine tuning and what did not work and adjust based off that.
- ➤ We currently have 2 Fulltime and 4 Part time openings. I have 5 additional applicants that I either have already or will be contacting for interviews.

Emergency Management Report

Preparedness Activities

- Updated documentation templates for damage assessments, debris tracking, and financial reporting have been completed and pre-positioned for immediate use in the event of a declared disaster.
- ICS/NIMS compliance (ICS 100, 200, 700, and 800) remains incomplete for some key personnel. Janet and I will continue working with all departments to ensure full compliance as soon as possible.

Planning Updates

- I continue to participate in monthly coordination meetings with Brazoria County partners regarding all events that may impact the region.
- Janet and I are in the process of **updating Village records** with photos, serial numbers, and detailed descriptions of all claimable assets.
- During FEMA meetings, we discovered significant gaps in previously maintained documentation required for reimbursement, which has added extra work for Eric, Toby, and Code Enforcement to resolve within FEMA's short timeframes.

Community Engagement

- As reported last month, the Emergency Management Department has received **two separate donations** allocated specifically to Emergency Management; these have been forwarded to Christie for processing.
- Bart has been in communication with me and the Mayor regarding **potential grant opportunities**. He is actively working on these items, and I will provide an update once available.

Interagency Coordination





Since the establishment of the Emergency Management Department in May, Janet, Christie, and I have participated in weekly FEMA coordination meetings regarding Hurricane Beryl. These sessions have been instrumental in improving our understanding of FEMA's documentation standards and reimbursement processes.

Through these efforts, we have:

- Identified and addressed documentation and procedural gaps from past disasters.
- Developed strategies to ensure future FEMA compliance and more efficient reporting.
- Established a framework to prevent recurrence of prior administrative issues.

Our focus remains on proactive planning, accurate documentation, and strong interagency coordination to ensure Surfside Beach is better prepared for future disaster events.

Disaster / Incident Updates

- FEMA meetings concerning **Hurricane Beryl** have highlighted recurring issues, particularly **poorly written invoices** from prior submissions. This has resulted in additional work for Toby, Eric, and Josh, and in some cases, has required removal of items from project lists, reducing reimbursement potential.
- Moving forward, all invoices for potential claimable items must meet FEMA's documentation standards for description, quantities, and verification.
- I want to recognize **Janet's outstanding effort** in working with FEMA to ensure the Village receives maximum compensation. Since my appointment as EMC in May, this process has been demanding, but it has allowed us to identify and correct numerous gaps in policies and protocols required by FEMA.
- Between Janet, Christie, and myself, we are building a more organized and compliant foundation to ensure Surfside Beach is **better prepared for future disaster-related** events.

Resource / Equipment Status

At this time, there are **no significant equipment or resource updates**. As Emergency Management is a newly established department, **no funding had been previously allocated** until this current fiscal year. I will move forward using the newly approved budget to begin building essential resources and capabilities for the department.

Overview of the 2025 Atlantic Hurricane Season

- U.S. Impact: No direct deaths or significant damages reported to date.

Key Points for Surfside Beach:

- The historical **peak of hurricane activity** is mid-August through late September, but storms can form into November.
- While the season remains slightly below NOAA's upper predictions, risk persists for late-season systems.
- Surfside Beach Emergency Management continues daily monitoring and stands ready to activate emergency operations if a threat arises.

Community Preparedness Recommendations

Residents and businesses are strongly encouraged to:

- Maintain emergency kits and evacuation plans.
- Monitor **official updates** from Surfside Beach Emergency Management, Brazoria County, and the National Hurricane Center.
- Use this current lull in storm activity to **inspect properties**, clear drains, secure outdoor items, and review insurance coverage.
