In late 1821, the *Lively*, a thirty-ton schooner set sail from New Orleans with approximately twenty colonists and supplies for a colony of 300 families recruited by Stephen F. Austin. Bad weather blew the ship off course, and it took some four weeks to reach its destination. On December 21, 1821, the immigrants landed at the mouth Brazos River, in what is modern day Surfside Beach.
