

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO ESTABLISH A
DEDICATED PURPOSE SALES TAX**

TO: ALL PERSONS ENTITLED TO VOTE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE OF SURFSIDE BEACH, TEXAS, AND ARE DULY REGISTERED TO VOTE IN THE PRECINCT WHERE AND ON THE DAY ON WHICH THEY VOTE, GREETINGS:

I.

You will take notice that a special election to establish a dedicated purpose sales tax will be held in and throughout the Village of Surfside Beach, Texas, ("the City") on the first Saturday in May, 2022, being the May 7, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of establishing a dedicated purpose sales tax

II.

To be eligible to vote in such election, a person must, on the date such person votes, be (1) eligible to vote under the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Texas Election Code, (2) a resident of the City, and (3) duly registered to vote in the Brazoria County, Texas, election precinct which includes that portion of the corporate limits of the City where such voter.


III.

For the purpose of this election, the Mayor and City Council of the City has established one (1) municipal polling place located within the corporate limits of said city for voting on the day of the election, being the Surfside Beach City Hall located 1304 Monument, Surfside Beach, Texas. On that day, voting will also be permitted during the hours and at the times specified by the Brazoria County Clerk, and as may be amended or updated by the Brazoria County Clerk.

IV.




