CPR Policy



CPR Instructors will be provided by Surfside Beach EMS. Instructors on hand as of February 6th, 2024, are EMS Director Charles Cahoon (EMT-P) and Assistant EMS Director Christopher Beall (EMT-B).

The course will go over Adult, Teen, and Infant CPR, how to administer an Epi Pen and how to operate an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED). The course will include audio and video lessons, workbook/handouts lessons, hands-on training, and a written test. After one has completed the class, they will have been trained and certified in AHA CPR for both Adult and Infant.

The Village of Surfside Beach Texas EMS will provide 4 Adult & Infant CPR mannequins, 4 practice AEDs, 2 practice EPI Pens, videos and worksheets for lessons, written test, and Instructor(s).

Cost for class will be:

Surfside Beach Texas Resident – 6\$ (must show proof of residence on TX DL)

First Responders – 6\$ per person (must have valid Department ID)

BLS Card Price Included

Non-Resident – 50\$ per person (75\$ if Instructor must travel up to a 30-mile radius of Surfside)

Non-Profit Group – 10\$ per person (15\$ if Instructor must travel up to a 30-mile radius of Surfside)

Educators - 15\$ per person, will need to show School employee ID (25\$ if Instructor must travel up to a 30-mile radius of Surfside)

CPR Card Price not included

BLS Provider Card – 5\$ per person

Heartsaver Provider Card – 20\$ per person

Class size 4-12 people at a time. Class length 4-6 hours

Certification is Valid for Two Years
